

STATE 2010 CHEERLEADING COMPETITION

Q: When and where is the STATE Cheerleading Competition?

A: March 13th at Bloomington Trinity.

Q: Where do I apply and when is the deadline?

A: You can only apply on-line at www.luthsports.org under the Cheerleading section. The deadline is Feb 25th at 11:59 pm CST.

Q: Are there any qualifications?

A: No, but the squad should have a prepared routine.

Q: Will there be a mat available during the competition?

A: Yes.

Q: What do I do if I lose my password?

A: Each school gets one password which will work for all events. First, make sure someone did not change the password. If the password is lost, e-mail acrouse@luthsports.org for a new password. Please include your city and school in the e-mail. The LSA may require further proof from the school (i.e. follow up phone call) that a new password is needed.

Q: How do I ensure our roster and record are correct in the program book?

A: After the deadline, the school will receive their roster for review. Carefully, read the information and make changes if necessary. The deadline for roster review and results is TBD. After this date, the program book must go to the publisher and any information from the application, correct or not, will go to the publisher.

Q: Do we have to stay in the hotels, or can we find our own?

A: The Cheerleading Event will be a one event that should not require a hotel stay, therefore the LSA is not sanctioning a hotel for Cheerleading.

Q: Where are the pictures being taken? Is it required to take squad photos?

A: Pictures will be taken on the day of the competition. A squad picture is required for the team award.

Q: Can our squad get their picture taken and/or pick up T-shirts at Grade School Basketball?

A: Yes. You may get your picture taken at Arlington Heights on Friday if your squad is attending Grade School Basketball. When you order T-shirts, you will be given a choice to pick up at Arlington Heights on March 5th or Bloomington on March 15th. Please note the deadlines for each pick-up date.

Q: Who gets free passes for the event?

A: Three free passes will be given to each team for coaches and assistant coaches.

Q: Will there be coach's books or coaches meetings?

A: There are no coach's books. All of the information will be on the website before the tournament. All of the information should be printed out and taken with you to the tournament. There will be a coaches meeting one hour before the competition.

Q: What is the difference between the two rounds of competition?

A: The first round of competition is to narrow the number of squads to eight for the final round. The scores from the first round will count for 30% of your tournament score. The final round of scores will make up 70% of the tournament score.

Q: How is the competition scored?

A: Refer to the [Supplemental Rules](#) for information on the competition itself.

Q: I wanted to buy some photos and T-shirts, but they ran out or it was too late. Where can I get photos or T-Shirts after the event?

A: Photos will be available to order online. You will have to contact rcrouse@luthsports.org to get T-shirts after the event. We strongly suggest pre-ordering T-shirts before the event.
